
THIS APPEARS TO BE A PLASTIC BUCKET. PROBABLY USED TO WASH OFF THE CASTS.

THESE ARE WET CASTS. I WOULD SAY THAT THEY ARE ONLY 20 MINUTES OR SO OLD. THEY WERE PULLED OUT OF THE GROUND AND WASHED OFF. THEY BECOME FULLY DRY ON THE OUTSIDE AND TURN WHITE IN ABOUT THREE OR FOUR HOURS, DEPENDS ON HUMIDITY/HEAT (SUNSHINE).
